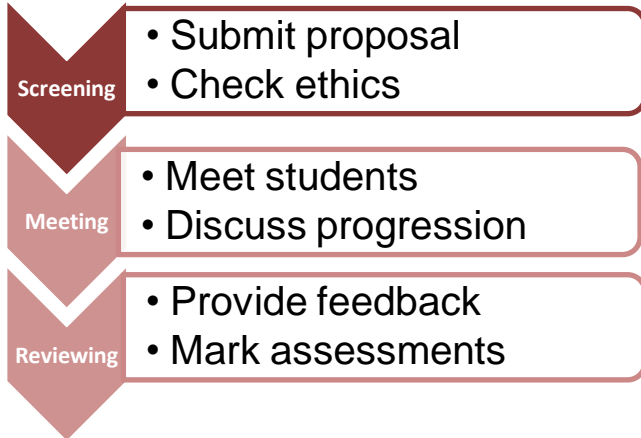

What supervisors do

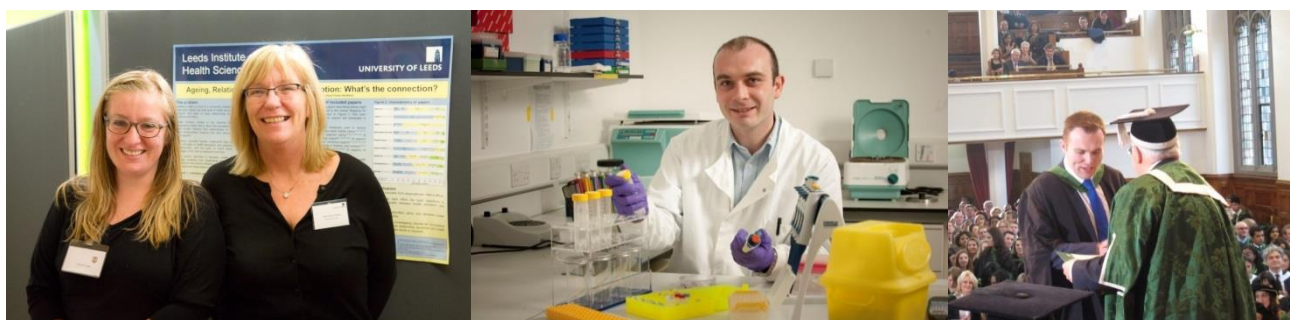


ESREP students work in pairs, allowing you to engage their interest and fascination in your speciality

As a supervisor, there is flexibility to meet with students within the allocated ESREP weeks. Supervisors are NHS or University staff. In Year 4 and 5 students work independently on their projects with your facilitation. Projects may be medical education, service evaluation, primary research or clinical audit.

Assessment and Feedback are important for student progression, the final mark for ESREP gives each medical student a grade which contributes to the award of honours points.

How long does it take?

AL1 Project Protocol	Score product, content and interpretation in grid. Free text comments on governance and pragmatism.	10 min per student	September
AL2 Rapid Literature Review	Score process, product, content and interpretation. Free text comments	30 min per student	November
AL3 Supervisor's Report	Score ownership, organisation and interactions. Free text comments	10 min per student	April
AP1 Oral Presentation	In a panel, attend a series of presentations, scoring clarity, interpretation and presentation skills. Provide free text comments as feedback.	3 h per group	Term 1 Year 5 (October)
AP2 Written Manuscript	Score product, structure, content and interpretation. Provide free text comments as feedback.	1 h per student	
AP3 Final Reflection	Score insight, professionalism, contributions.	30 min per student
